

## Question / Answer

Our shower area has one wall which is double brick, the other wall timber stud framed with proposed cement sheet to go up before tiling. My question is can you tile directly onto the brick wall or do you need also to cement sheet that? Or any other preparation before tiling?

I am virtually certain that all of our adhesive manufacturers produce a thick-bed type adhesive which will adhere tiles direct to brick. You must ensure that the brickwork is free of loose particles and is sound and flat enough to receive tile. Priming the surface is an absolute must. Check with your glue supplier , they probably produce an adhesive that you can apply to the brick and the cement sheet.
